

- Homicide: 18
  - 4 Murders
  - 14 Unexplained Deaths
- Robbery, Petty Theft, Grand Theft, Burglary (residential, commercial, other): 285
- Automotive related crimes: 248
  - 238 are auto burglaries
  - 1 forcible entry (car jacking)
- Misdemeanor and Felony Assault: 94
  - Includes a range of descriptions from 'wilful discharge of firearm in negligent manner' to 'cruelty to elder'




#### All Crimes 2021

Areas of Note (not including Grand Ave)

- A MacArthur Blvd/Orange St to Vernon St.
  - Highway off ramp/access from Oakland Ave / Bus stop.
- B Euclid Ave
  - Relatively straight, direct access to Grand Ave
- C Vernon St, Montecito Ave & Lee St.
  - Historically a hot spot for strong arm robberies.
  - People attacked while walking to/from BART & Whole Foods
- D Central Perkins St & Jayne Ave
  - Main access point from Grand, higher foot traffic.


#### Automotive related crimes: 248



- Grand Ave is the main corridor in which automotive crimes are committed.
- In addition, the crimes occur at busy intersections
  - Grand Ave & Bellevue Ave
  - Grand Ave & Perkins St
  - Grand Ave & Ellita Ave
     /Staten Ave
  - Grand from Euclid Ave to MacArthur Blvd


## Robbery, Petty Theft, Grand Theft, Burglary: 285

(residential, commercial, other)




- Higher traffic streets seem prone to more of these crimes.
- This includes streets that connect directly to Grand Ave
  - Vernon St, Lee St, Euclid Ave

## Felony Assault and Misdemeanor



- It was surprising to see Grand & Perkins as such a hot spot
- Secondary is the AHN's burger at Grand Ave & Bellevue Ave
  - This area has been a problem area for residents living there for several years.
  - Vehicle encampments on Bellevue.
- Grand Ave, Bay PI, & Harrison St is another encampment location.
  - Multiple encampment fires, vagrants surrounding 7/11

### Homicide: 24



- Our greater objective is to create a safe neighborhood.
- We want to deter anyone intent upon committing crimes, and ensuring that crimes are recorded, reported, and prosecuted.

# Points to consider when formulating solutions:

- Geography: access points, building types & nearby building types, straight or curved roads, public transportation, access to main avenues
- Human Behavior: travel by foot/bicycle/car, time of day, who
  is visiting these locations, where are people coming from /
  going to, real estate turnover
- Environmental Conditions: wide/narrow streets, illumination at night, single family home or multifamily home, speed bumps, open access garages, high visitor traffic, central business district organization
